Cape Cod conjures thoughts of pristine seashores, the call of seagulls, tidy clapboard homes, Colonial historic sites and fresh local seafood. Join us as we experience the unique charm of Olde Cape Cod!

Day 1 (D)

This morning we depart on our flight bound for Boston. Upon arrival we will be met by a deluxe motor coach and whisked away to charming and historic Cape Cod. Our hotel for the first three nights of our tour will be the **Blue Water Resort**, a classic Cape Cod hotel situated on a private sandy beach with breathtaking views. After settling into your room, take a walk on the beach, have a drink in the lounge or relax on your private balcony or patio. This evening we depart for dinner at **The Paddock Restaurant**, considered a Cape Cod institution and a "must do" on Cape Cod. Day 2 (B, D)

Enjoy a hot breakfast before we begin our **full-day guided tour of Cape Cod**. Our local guide will escort us through areas of scenic beauty and to many sites of historic interest. Our tour includes stops at the John F. Kennedy Memorial and the Korean War Memorial in Hyannisport. We'll drive by St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer church of the Kennedy family. Then we'll travel historic Route 6A, the Old King's Highway, which is a Scenic Byway that winds through centuries of Cape Cod history. See the Eastham Windmill and a historic lighthouse. We'll drive through the **Cape Cod National Seashore** area where sand dunes and the ocean surround you. At the very tip of the Cape we'll stop in **Provincetown** where you can enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists and fishermen's village so unique.



Upon our return to the hotel you will have time to relax before we depart for another wonderful dinner. Tonight we will dine at the **Riverway Lobster House**, a Cape Cod tradition since 1944. Enjoy a luscious lobster dinner or other entrée, if you prefer.



Day 3 (B, D)

Have a hearty breakfast this morning before we depart for another fun day! Today we will cruise by ferry across Nantucket Sound to lovely **Nantucket Island**, one of the most unique, historic, and visually stunning places in the world. Originally a booming whaling port, Nantucket has been named a National Historic District and has architecturally changed little since the 17th century, as seaside cottages and old-fashioned lamps still line its streets. You will have plenty of time for exploring the charming streets of Nantucket where there are many inviting shops and restaurants.



Your tour director will also have information for you on the fabulous Whaling Museum and one-hour island tours that are available as options.

We return by ferry later this afternoon and then enjoy a relaxing dinner at our hotel.



Day 4 (B, D)

After breakfast this morning we check out and travel to Boston. Upon our arrival you will have time to visit historic **Faneuil Hall** and have lunch and shop at festive **Quincy Market**. We then meet our wonderful guide for a **tour of Boston**. We'll drive by the Charlestown Navy Yard where "Old Ironsides" is berthed and visit the famous Old North Church. We'll travel the historic Freedom Trail and see the Old Granary Burial Ground where Paul Revere, John Hancock and Samuel Adams are buried. We'll see Beacon Hill, the popular "Cheers" bar and so much more!

Later this afternoon we check into the **Hampton Inn, Boston Logan Airport - Revere** for some time to relax and refresh. Then it's off to one of Boston's most popular eateries, **McCormick & Schmick's**. Uniquely designed to create an inviting and relaxed atmosphere, this restaurant features the freshest of foods and will be the perfect place to enjoy your final night dinner and the company of your traveling companions.

Day 5 (B)

Breakfast is included at the hotel before we check out. This morning we will visit the outstanding **John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum**. Located on a ten-acre park, overlooking the sea that he loved and the city that launched him to greatness, the Library stands as a vibrant tribute to the life and times of John F. Kennedy. Afterwards, we're on our way to the Boston airport for our flight back home. We'll be taking with us wonderful memories of captivating Olde Cape Cod and historic and exciting Boston!
